



Docusate Sodium

100 Tablets 100 mg each **Directions** • adults and children 12 years and older: take 1-2 tablets daily until first bowel movement; 1 tablet daily thereafter, or as directed by a doctor • children under 12: consult a doctor • do not exceed recommended dose

Other information • each tablet contains: calcium 50 mg, sodium 8 mg • store at room temperature 15°C-30°C (59°F-86°F) • **Tamper Evident:** Do not use if imprinted seal under cap is missing or broken.

Inactive ingredients: cellulose, croscarmellose sodium, dicalcium phosphate, magnesium stearate, silica, stearic acid, talc

Docusate Sodium 100 mg.....Stool Softener Laxative

Uses • relieves occasional constipation (irregularity)
• generally produces bowel movement in 12 to 72 hours

Warnings

Ask a doctor before use if you • have stomach pain, nausea or vomiting • have a sudden change in bowel habits that persists over a period of 2 weeks • are presently taking mineral oil

Stop use and ask a doctor if • you need to use a laxative longer than 1 week • you have rectal bleeding or fail to have a bowel movement. These could be signs of a serious condition.

If pregnant or breast-feeding, ask a health professional before use.

Keep out of the reach of children. In case of overdose, get medical help or contact a Poison Control Center right away.
