Directions for Use:

- 1. Insert a test strip to turn on the meter.
- 2. Take an auto-disabling lancing device. Hold the lancing device firmly against the puncture site and puncture to get a drop of blood.
- 3. Gently squeeze around the punctured area to obtain enough blood.
- 4. While a blood drop is flashing on the display, hold and touch the absorbent hole of the test strip to the drop of blood until the confirmation window is completely covered.
- 5. After the meter counts to zero, the test result will appear along with date and time and will be automatically stored in the memory.
- 6. To turn off the meter, remove the test strip.
- 7. Discard used test strip and lancet device carefully.
- 8. Disinfect the meter as instructed in the Owner's Manual and change gloves before testing another patient.







Your blood glucose result will display the following:

Lo: Glucose level is less than 20 mg/dL (1.1 mmol/L)

Hi: Glucose level is greater than 600 mg/dL (33.3 mmol/L)

KETONE? : Glucose level is less than or equal to 240 mg/dL (13.3 mmol/L)
